


# Exhibition Out of Your Mind and on to the Page: Art Journaling for the Fearful Output Tournaling for the Fearful Reco

Four Mondays: April 28, May 5, May 12, May 19 from 10:00 AM - 1:00 PM

Making your own feast for the eyes and the mind - this class is designed to ignite your imagination and get your fingers moving to create your own special magic on the page. The class will start with a little Show and Tell, and then move on to making friends with the blank page in front of you. We'll start with the basic tools I use in my journals - pens, pencil, and watercolor - and as the weeks progress, I hope you'll add your own favorite tools and colors. drawing or lettering or layout to take this class. Each of us will start right where we are, and learn by doing. The most important thing to bring to class is your willingness to pour out your heart on to the page. It is that, more than your artistic skill, which will give your journal its value, and make it uniquely yours.

Nancy Hays Hills is an artist and Episcopal deacon living in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Her working career was in the field of advertising and graphic design from which she retired in 2020 to devote more time to her dual vocations of ministry and art. She shares a home with her husband Julian, and her trusty feline sidekick, Samantha.

She began drawing as soon as she could hold a crayon, and was lucky enough to have parents who encouraged their shy child to express herself on paper. She took her first calligraphy course at age 17 and has incorporated lettering in her art ever since.

In addition to individual pieces, she has been working in art journals for over 20 years, and her artwork from those journals has appeared in Alphabet, Bound & Lettered, and in the most recent Speedball Textbook.
